Laveena explained the Role of jeevasarthakathe, statistics of Jeevasarthakathe, Hospital details etc. Around 60 people attended this programme.



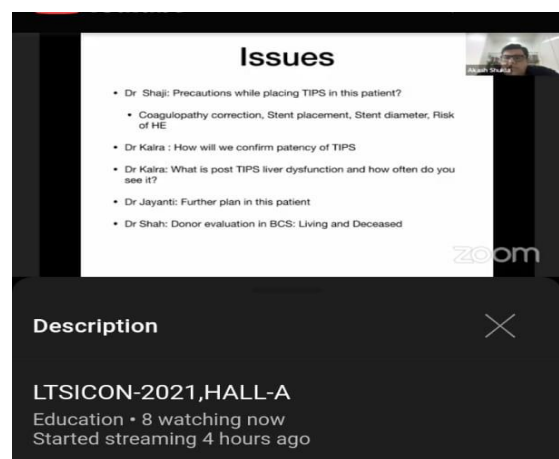
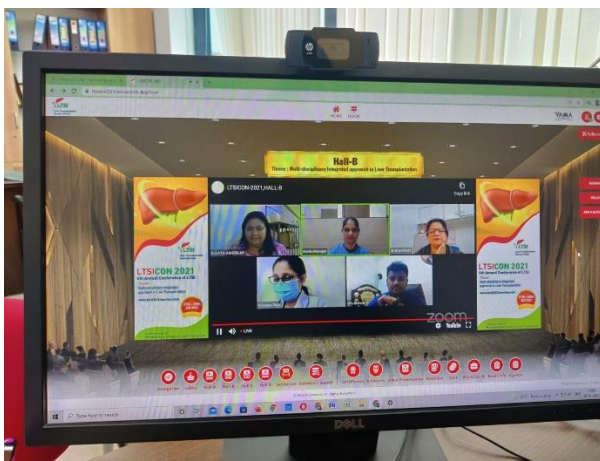

Course Objective

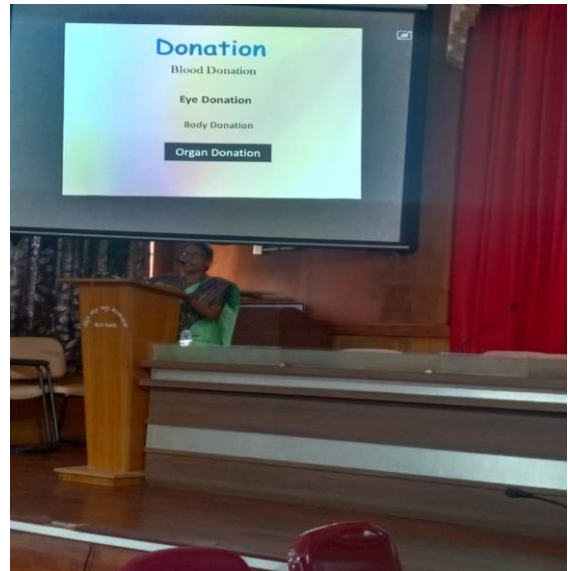

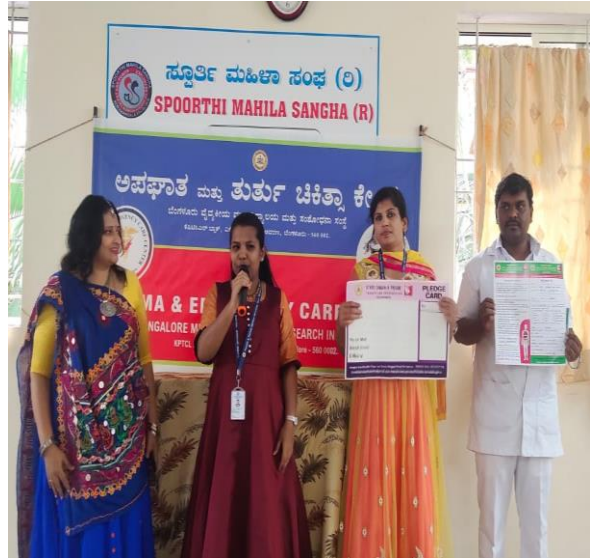

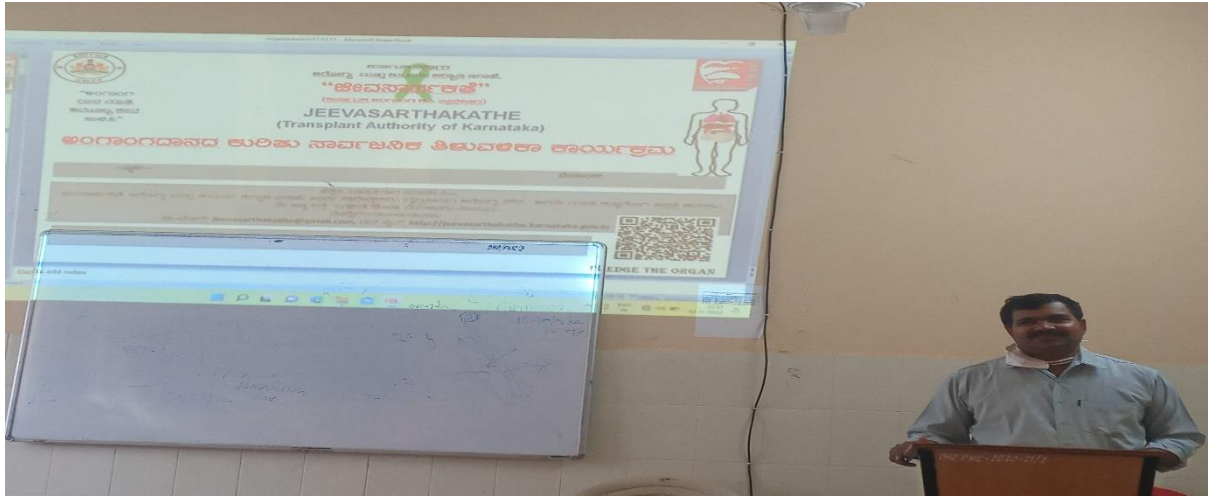
